In the competitive world of business it takes a combination of leadership, product and financial acumen to stand out from the crowd.

Classic Construction in Medicine Hat has been ranked among the best for the third year in a row, according to Alberta Venture Magazine's Fast 50.

"We ranked Alberta's companies by growth in revenues, assets, profits, head count and other criteria over the past three years," said Murray Prokosch, CEO.

This is the second year Classic Construction has been ranked in the over \$20 million revenue category. They are also the only Southern Alberta company featured with most of the competition located in Calgary and Edmonton.

"With a three-year revenue increase of 171 per cent and assets

totaling more than \$37 million, Classic Construction Ltd., continues its unprecedented growth with expansions into new markets in Alberta such as High River and Canmore," said Prokosch.

Classic Construction is committed to building affordable housing but redefining that label, adding aesthetically pleasing features that include granite countertops and five appliances.

Hatters are most familiar with Classic's new home communities in Crescent Heights — Northlands Pointe and Northland Villa's and Somerset Villas located behind Home Depot.

"Regardless of any possible downturn in housing construction we're targeting the entry level market and expect business to continue to be very good through 2009. We have several projects in the works, one in Medicine Hat, one in Lethbridge and possibly one in Saskatchewan," said Prokosch.
