This is truly an example of the private sector identifying a need and following through from concept to implementation at no cost to the taxpayer.

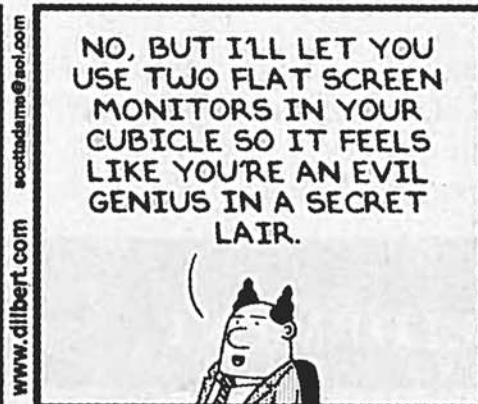
Many of the candidates in Monday's civic election have sited affordable housing as a major need for our
